

2017 CONDITIONS FOR INTERCLUB NIGHT PENNANT COMPETITION

- Controlling body:** SCDMBA Executive and Match Committee
- Green fees:** Green fees will be paid to the player's home club, at the Club's ruling rate.
- Commencement date:** First round to be played during the week commencing 2nd October 2017 and the last game week commencing 6^h November 2017 with the final week commencing 14th November 2017.
- Start of play:** 6.00 p.m
- Game time:** Maximum of 3 hours. Host Club may terminate game at an earlier time due to weather/green conditions.
- Attire:** A team may wear club shirts or white or a combination of both. Trousers or shorts are permitted.
- Date of game:** SCDMBA to set week of play. Date to be set by Host Club. Opposition must be advised well in advance
- Practice :** Practice shall be allowed up until 10 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time and shall be allowed on any available rink. This replaces the need for trial ends. This will also allow for the inspection of bowls in a timely manner prior the scheduled start time".
- Sections and Sides** Two sections – North and South of Maroochydore. Club Maroochy included in south section. Clubs may nominate one or more sides in a section.

- Interchange of players:** No interchange of players is allowed after 3rd round, including the final. This also refers to clubs who have more than one team.
Any infringement will be disqualification of the Side.
- Qualification of a Player For Finals:** A player must have played at least two (2) games prior to the finals to compete in the finals

Inclement Weather:

Should any individual match or matches be impossible to commence due to inclement weather, or an unplayable green at a particular Club, then the match must be played within fourteen (14) days. The clubs involved will determine time and place. If both clubs cannot agree to replay, then each club will receive half the points available. If one team forfeits, then the other will receive maximum points available plus the average of the winning margins and losing margins of that round and in that Division.

Play under lights will be permitted

To constitute a Game at least 8 ends must be played by each team. If the game is abandoned, it will not be replayed, and such Game will be declared drawn. Each Club will be allocated half the point on offer plus the average of the winning margins and losing margins of that round and in that Division.

Points:

1 point for each rink win (a half for a draw)

3 points for overall win based on rinks won.

Results:

Home Team Managers are to scan and email results to Games Recorder as soon as possible after completion of game.

Byes:

Teams with Byes do not receive points.

Forfeits:

In the case of a forfeiture or disqualification, the side which has forfeited or was disqualified will receive no game points and the loss of the average marginal points lost by the losing Side in that round in that Division and /or Sections in that Division. The Side receiving the forfeit or a win through disqualification will receive the maximum game points and the average marginal points gained by the winning Sides in that round, in that Division and/or Sections in that Division.

Competition winner:

To be determined by a play-off between the top side in each section, North V South.

Winning side to receive a flag and each player of winning side to receive a badge.
