POLICY 07/23 ATTIRE (as amended)

Application

This policy applies to all personnel who represent the Association in any capacity, and players and officials selected to represent their Club and/or the SCDBA in any competition organized by the Sunshine Coast District or in which the player is representing the SCDBA.

This amended policy was endorsed by the Management Committee at their meeting on 19th January 2026 and shall remain in effect indefinitely.

Limitations

This Policy is governed by the directions contained within Bowls Queensland By-Law 14.

Details: -

1. The Sunshine Coast District Bowls Association is responsible for implementing a dress standard for events under its control. These standards are based on and do not conflict with the State body.
2. The clubs shall determine their club uniform for side events (pennant and above) which will be approved by the SCDBA and registered with Bowls Queensland.
3. "above" is District, State and National events.
4. Districts shall determine their District uniform which will be registered with Bowls Queensland.
5. Neat attire is encouraged for use in all other forms of bowls competitions and activities, including club competitions and social bowls. Each club is encouraged to define its Club Attire Policy in this regard.
6. The SCDBA shall determine the dress code to be adopted by individuals and teams/sides when representing the district.
 - a. The SCDBA shirt will be as per the registered design.
 - b. The Lower Body Attire will be either Shorts, Slacks, Skirts or Skorts, with bowls Logo, color is Royal Blue.
7. Districts shall determine their District uniform which will be registered with Bowls Queensland.
8. For District Champion of Club Champions competitions, entrants will wear their approved Club Attire. (Subject to item 10.)
9. For all Pennant Competitions, all teams will wear their approved Club Attire, (subject to item 10)
10. Where a Club has more than one approved shirt design, all members of a team will wear the most recently approved shirt unless prior written approval is given by the District Match Chairperson.
11. Where a Club obtains approval for a new shirt design, consideration needs to be given to the practicality of the change-over and how such change may affect their compliance with items 8 and 9 above. As a guide, SCDBA considers that a maximum of 12 months tolerance for complete changeover of shirts is a reasonable time.
12. In specific circumstances, Conditions of Play for an event, may override this, Policy.

Breaches

Any reported breach of the Attire Policy shall be dealt with in accordance with the SCDBA Discipline Policy 02/23.
